

- **3.** Works in private homes caring for their employer's babies and young children (5).
- **4.** Helps and advises families with long or short-term difficulties (6,7,6).
- **7.** Understands child development and uses therapeutic play activities to help children cope when in hospital (6,4,10).
- **9.** Helps babies and children up to 5 years old to develop and learn in a safe and supportive setting (7,6).
- **10.** Helps vulnerable people to manage their daily activities and to live as independently as possible (4,6).
- Provides specialist end of life care and support to patients and their families (10,4,9).
