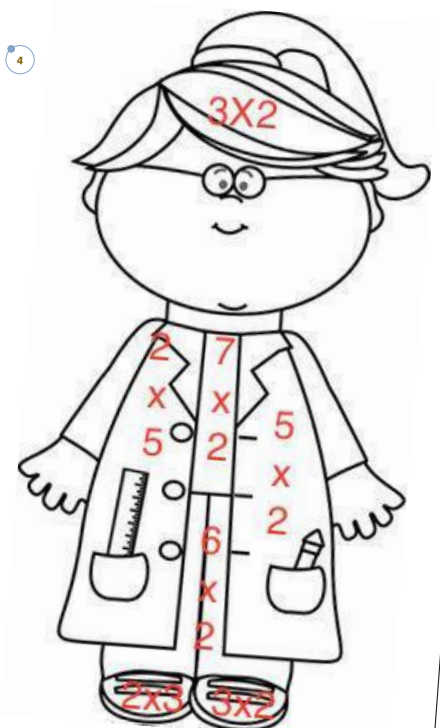

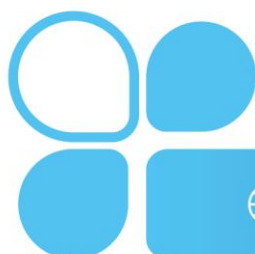

- For remote learning

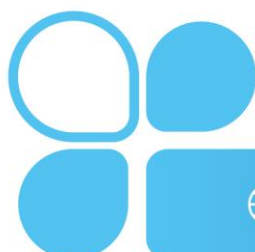
