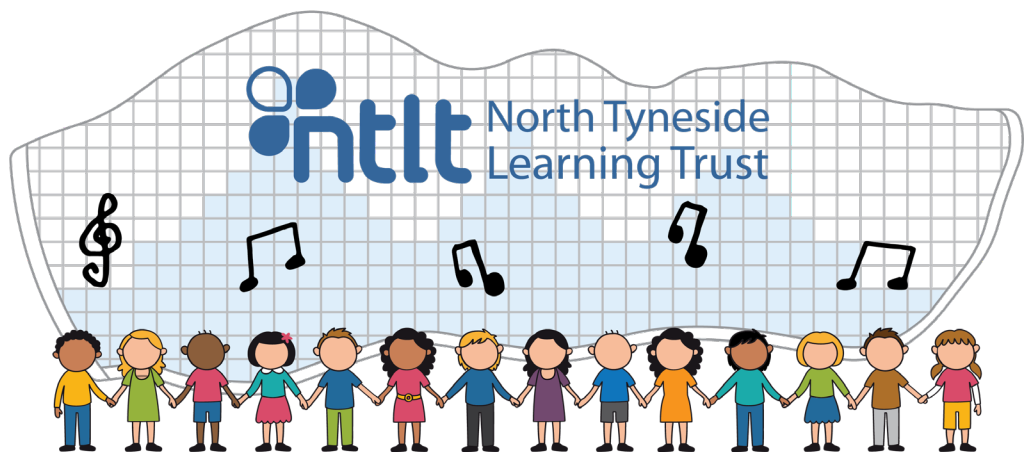

NTLT believe passionately in inspiring the next generation to find their love for music.

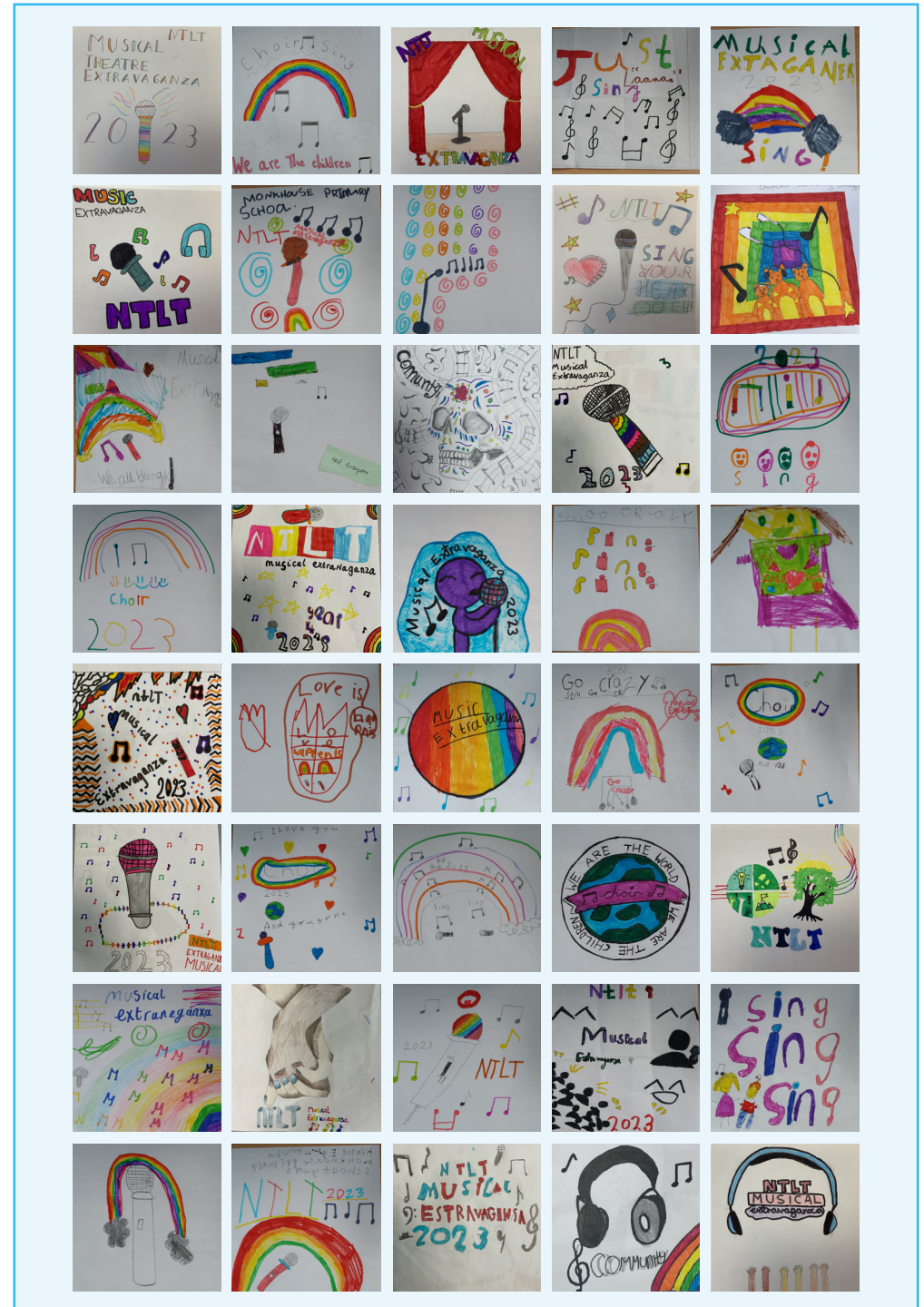
This Musical Extravaganza performance showcases talent from across our collaborative partnership of schools. Over 400 children and young people will perform tonight as a single choir.

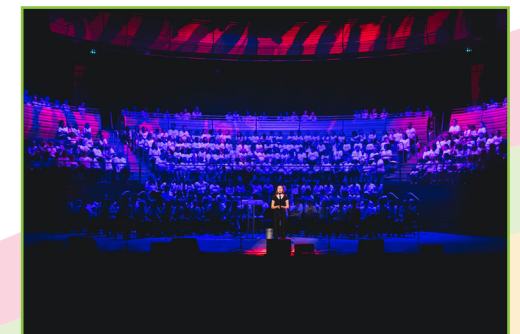
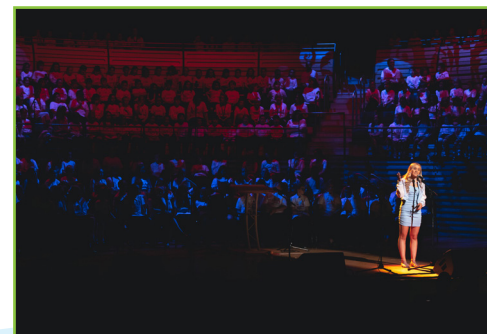

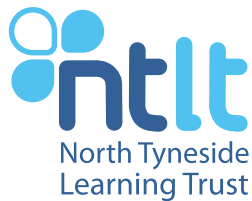
