**Career Speed Dating** - students work in groups and have approx. 5 minutes to go around each employer in turn and find out as much as possible about their job.

**Careers Fair** - an opportunity to give pupils and students information about employment opportunities and courses within your organisation.

**Mock Interviews** – students are interviewed and the ambassador will then provide feedback.

**Employer Workshops** - practical activity lasting 50-60 minutes

**CareerZone Workshops** - practical activities lasting 20-30 minutes. Students visit one employer from each sector.

**Enterprise Day** - The session aims to give an idea of the world of work and the employability and work-related skills needed in order to succeed. The employers role in the task is to act as a seller for the purchasing of materials and as a buyer for the completed product and to judge.
