Career Speed Dating - students work in groups and have approx. 5 minutes to go around each employer in turn and find out as much as possible about their job.

Careers Fair - an opportunity to give pupils and students information about employment opportunities and courses within your organisation.

Mock Interviews – students are interviewed and the ambassador will then provide feedback.

Employer Workshops - practical activity lasting 50-60 minutes

CareerZone Workshops - practical activities lasting 20-30 minutes. Students visit one employer from each sector.

Enterprise Day - The session aims to give an idea of the world of work and the employability and work-related skills needed in order to succeed. The employers role in the task is to act as a seller for the purchasing of materials and as a buyer for the completed product and to judge.
